## Curriculum

### **English**

This term we will be looking at what makes a good character. We will write a character description about a preferred character in a story including details on his/her appearance, qualities, thoughts and actions. We will compare similarities and differences of characters in texts.

#### Maths

Topics we will be covering this term include: number patterns, 2 digit numbers, fractions, telling time (to the quarter hour), adding and subtracting, 2D and 3D shapes, exploring money, using a calendar to identify the dates and identifying the months included in seasons, multiplication and division. We will also be learning a variety of problem solving strategies.

#### **HASS**

This term we continue our term 1 unit, 'What is a place?' We will look at the geographical divisions in the world and places at different scales (eg. personal, local, regional, national, global). We will pose questions, use maps, identify key features that define a place and describe locations of places.

#### **Science**

This term we will understand how a push or pull affects how an object moves or changes shape. This unit will be combine with Digital Technologies.

#### The Arts

In Media Art, students explore the existence and impact of sound as a representation of settings and characters in the community. They will develop a soundscape composition through the arrangement and manipulation of background sound, sound effects, text and imagery.

## **Design Technology**

Students will design and make a spinning toy for a small child that is fun and easy to use based around concepts learnt in Science.
