- When baking a cake, please practice good hygiene, ensuring benches and utensils are disinfected, hands washed (gloves may be used if you have available) etc.
- Please wrap your cake (in the packaging provided) as soon as practicable after it has been cooked.


## **CLOTHES AND BOOKS – DONATIONS CLOSE WEDNESDAY 28 APRIL!**

### **COVID SAFE EVENT PLAN**

The Sherwood Family Fun Day will operate under COVID Safe event guidelines. Some of the measures include:

- QKR Pre-event registration (pre-ticketing) you can register your intent to attend the event via the school QKR App. There is now an option under *P&C Activities and Events* to select the *Family Fun Day (Fete) 2021*. We encourage everyone to do this so numbers can be monitored.
- **QR code** requirement upon entry on the day (if you <u>haven't</u> already pre-registered vis QKR) this will be an option for non-school attendees.
- Hand Sanitiser stations will be available around the event grounds.
- Regular cleaning of amenities and high touch areas.
- BYO chairs and picnic rugs.
- Cut-off date for donations of books and clothes to allow them to "sit" for a period before sale.
- COVID Safe guidelines for stalls.

We will continue to remind everyone about the key health messages such as:

- Stay at home if unwell;
- Maintaining physical distancing requirements;
- Regular hand washing and sanitising during the event;
- Adhere to the public health measures that are in place at the event;
- Download the Commonwealth Government COVID-19 app prior to attending the event;
- Not attending the event if:
  - o You have been in close contact with a person who is positive for COVID-19
  - You are positive for COVID-19
  - You have travelled overseas or to a declared COVID-19 Hotspot in the previous 14 days.
