Holiday Practice

Please make sure there is a little bit of practice going on each day over the holidays. No practice for 2 weeks will set the students back a long way! Muscle memory is developed slowly over many repetitions of a particular concept, so just like learning to walk it needs to happen every day before a child is successful! Please take the time to listen to their music as they work on it, and don't be scared to ask them questions or make suggestions. Youtube is a great place to hunt for recordings of music if you are not sure how a melody should sound. Recording your child and letting them listen to themselves can prove useful too. A video of themselves lets them look at how they are standing or sitting when playing. Alignment while playing has a great impact on their sound and how efficiently they can use their body to play the instrument. Their music books are full of useful information about what they are learning and how they should look when they play. The more involved you are in their music, the more they will value it as a way to connect not only with you, but with the rest of the world.
