Subject Overview

English

In this unit students listen to, read and view a range of literary imaginative texts that contain certain structural elements and language features that reflect an informative text. Students create, rehearse and present a procedure in front of their peers.

Maths

This term we will be covering the following topics: time (days, months and seasons), skip counting, 2-digit numbers, measuring length, adding and subtracting, and chance and data! Don't forget to use Mathletics at home as it is a great online learning tool.

HASS

This term the focus is on 'What is a place?' We will look at the geographical divisions in the world and places at different scales (personal, local, regional, national, global). We will pose questions, use maps, identify key features that define a place and describe locations of places.

Science

This term the focus of our unit is Properties of Materials. We will be looking at what different materials are used for and the reasons why based on their known properties (e.g. strong, waterproof, hard, smooth).

Specialist classes

Dance

Throughout the semester students make and respond to dance by exploring dance from other countries and cultural groups as stimulus.

Design Technology

Students will design and make a spinning toy that is fun and easy to use based around concepts learnt in Science.

Digital Technologies

Students will be focussing on developing their foundational skills in computational thinking and an awareness of personal experiences using digital systems.

Health

In this unit, students examine the purpose of advertising and the techniques used to engage children. They explore health messages seen in advertising and how they can be used to make good decisions about their own and others' health and wellbeing.

PE

In this unit, students will demonstrate fundamental movement skills (instep pass, punt kick and one hand strike) and test alternatives to solve management challenges (to reach their targets). We will be building up our endurance for cross country and participate in our swimming block.
