NB: Prep students are not allocated homework in Term 1. Home reading will begin once classroom teachers ascertain individual child's readiness for the home reading programme.

At Sherwood State School, it is expected that students complete reading and Reading Eggs/Mathseeds or Mathletics tasks each week. **Students who opt in** to the Student Resource Scheme will receive usernames and passwords for web based programmes. Families who have **not opted** in to the SRS need to arrange to purchase subscriptions for these web based programmes.

The homework cycle is Monday to Monday. Tasks will be set by classroom teachers on Monday and checked on the following Monday. Class teachers will monitor completion of online homework.
