



UNIFORM POLICY

Purpose:

The Sherwood State School expects that all students will abide by the school's Uniform Policy and wear the school uniform every day. We ask that students wear the proper school uniform every day for the following reasons:-

- Encourages school pride, promotes a sense of belonging and adds to students' self-respect.
- Demonstrates a unified school identity and promotes a strong public image throughout the wider community.
- Decreases competition amongst students and makes daily clothing selection straight-forward.
- Increases safety in the playground and on excursions, enabling easy identification of Sherwood State School students.
- Promotes sun safety and complies with the Departments guidelines.

Uniform:

Uniform options

- red polo shirt (with the school logo) and royal blue shorts or culottes; or
- blue, red and white checked dress. It is recommended that sports briefs or equivalent be worn when wearing this uniform.

Hat

- Royal blue wide brimmed hat (preferably with the school logo) must be worn. A strict "no hat, no play" policy is enforced at our school.
- Prep students wear a red legionnaire hat (so they can be easily identified).

Shoes

- Preferred footwear is joggers.
- Footwear must be enclosed.

Winter

- Jacket (preferably with school logo).
- Pants (preferably with the school logo).
- Alternatively, a royal blue jumper or track pants may be worn in winter (no jeans).
- Royal blue leggings, tights or stockings can be worn under skorts, shorts or dresses.

The following items are not permitted:-

- Jeans
- Hooded jumpers
- Vests
- Alternatively coloured jumpers

House Shirts

- House coloured shirt for athletics and cross country events.
- Radcliffe (green); Simpson (yellow) and Boyland (blue).
- House shirts are available from the uniform shop.

Senior Students

- Senior shirt (available from the uniform shop)

Hair

- Hair style is to be neat and tidy and of natural colour.
- Hair accessories are to be in school colours.

Jewellery (worn at the student's own risk of damage or loss)

- Earrings (sleepers/studs only. Maximum 2 sets)
- Medical bracelets or pendants
- Watch
- Signet ring
- No makeup or nail polish

Music/Choir

Students who are part of the music and choir groups pay an annual amount of \$20 to cover music uniform hire. This fee allows them to go up a size as required.

Swimming

A sun-safe shirt, swimming cap and sunscreen is essential for swimming lessons.

Free Dress Day

Clothing must be sun safe and must not have inappropriate or offensive imagery or wording. Singlets, midriff tops, thongs, sandals, or high heels are not permitted.
