



WELCOME BACK PREP NEWS TERM 4

ENGLISH - students will have multiple opportunities to read, examine and respond to literature and explore text structure and organisation.

Students will create a short imaginative multimodal text that includes illustrations, in a letter format. They engage in multiple opportunities to learn about language, literature and literacy within the five contexts of learning - focused teaching and learning, play, real life situations, investigations, and routines and transitions.

MATHS – students apply a variety of mathematical concepts in real-life, lifelike and purely mathematical situations.

Through the proficiency strands - understanding, fluency, problem-solving and reasoning - students have opportunities to develop understandings of:

Number and place value, Using units of measurement, Location and transformation



SCIENCE - students engage in activities from the five contexts of learning: Play, Real-life situations, Investigations, Routines and transitions, and Focused learning and teaching.

Students will use their senses to observe and explore the properties and movement of objects. They will recognise that science involves exploring and observing using the senses.

HASS – My special places

Students will explore the following inquiry question:
What are places like and what makes them special?
