

UNIFORM POLICY

Purpose

The Sherwood State School expects that all students will abide by the school's *Uniform Policy* and wear the correct school uniform every day.

We ask that students wear the proper school uniform every day, as it:

- Encourages school pride, promotes a sense of belonging, and adds to students' self-respect.
- Demonstrates a unified school identity and fosters a strong public image throughout the wider community.
- Decreases competition amongst students and makes daily clothing selection straight-forward.
- Increases safety in the playground and on excursions, enabling easy identification of Sherwood State School students.
- Complies with the Department's sun safety guidelines.

Uniform

Shirts	 Red school polo shirt - with the school logo (either short or long-sleeved) Senior shirt (royal blue) for Year 6 students only
Shorts	Royal blue shorts, culottes or skort
Dresses	• Blue, red and white checked dress - with the school logo It is recommended that sports briefs or equivalent be worn when wearing this uniform.
Winter option	 School jacket (preferably with school logo) Alternatively, a plain royal blue or red jumper Royal blue pants Blue leggings, tights or stockings can be worn under skorts, shorts or dresses
Hats	 Years 1-6 Blue wide brimmed hat (preferably with the school logo) Prep Red wide brimmed hat (so they can be easily identified)
Shoes	 A strict "no hat, no play" policy is enforced at our school. Black shoes or dark coloured joggers Footwear must be enclosed
Socks	Plain white or black socks
House Shirts For athletics and cross-country events	 Coloured polo shirt: Radcliffe – green Simpson – yellow Boyland – blue
The following items are <u>not</u> permitted: Jeans Vests or coloured undershirts Alternatively coloured imports 	

• Alternatively coloured jumpers

Hair

- Hair style is to be neat and tidy and of natural colour.
- Any hair accessories are to be in school colours.

Jewellery (worn at the student's own risk of damage or loss)

- Earrings (sleepers/studs only maximum 2 x sets)
- Medical bracelets or pendants
- Watch
- Signet ring
- No makeup or nail polish

Swimming

• A sun-safe shirt, swimming cap and sunscreen is essential for swimming lessons.

Music/Choir

Students who are part of the music and choir groups pay an annual amount of \$20 to cover music uniform hire. This fee allows them to go up a size as required.

Free Dress Day

Clothing must not have inappropriate or offensive imagery or wording. Singlets, midriff tops, thongs, sandals, or high heels are not permitted.
