**Sherwood State School will receive**

**\$204,639\***

**This funding will be used to**

- Increase percentage of Year 3 students in Reading U2B from 56% to >60% by 2015
- Increase percentage of Year 3 students in Numeracy U2B from 37% to >60% by 2015
- Increase the % of students in Prep reading at PM Benchmark 5 from 36% to 50% in 2014
- Increase % in Year 1 achieving at or above B for maths from 65% to 70% in 2014
- Increase % in Year 2 achieving at or above B for maths from 62% to 70% in 2014
- Maintain NMS in Year 3, 5 & 7 reading and maths >95% and complete an ILP for any students not achieving the benchmark in 2014

**Our strategy will be to**

- Use a continuous process in Reading and Numeracy to assess students' current performance; teach to the needs of students; and re-assess students to monitor improvement.
- Provide ongoing professional learning, coaching and constructive feedback to teachers and teacher aides to implement consistent, whole-of-school, evidence based effective teaching strategies

• Employ HOC	\$ 128,000
• Teacher Aides	45,000
• Enhancing wireless: Wireless P-3 learning areas	6,000
• Specialist support: Employing specialist to address student needs	20,639
